The Municipality of Anchorage, in cooperation with the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, is planning a two-part street improvement in your area.

LAKE OTIS PARKWAY: 68th Avenue to Abbott Road Rehabilitation

This is mainly a repaving effort, with spot improvements where needed. These may include:

- Curb ramps upgraded to Americans with Disabilities (ADA) standards
- Drainage, pedestrian path, and sight distance improvements
- Traffic Signal and Approach Modifications at 88th Avenue
- New Traffic Signals at Lore Road and at 72nd Avenue



88th AVENUE: Between Lake Otis Parkway and Toloff Street

This is a substantial road reconstruction to upgrade the present street to Municipal Commercial Collector 1A standards and may address the following:

- Providing curb & gutter, and storm drainage
- Pedestrian pathway and sidewalks
- Road structure and paving
- Street Lighting

These projects are funded by a combination of Municipal road bonds and TEA-21 (federal funds).

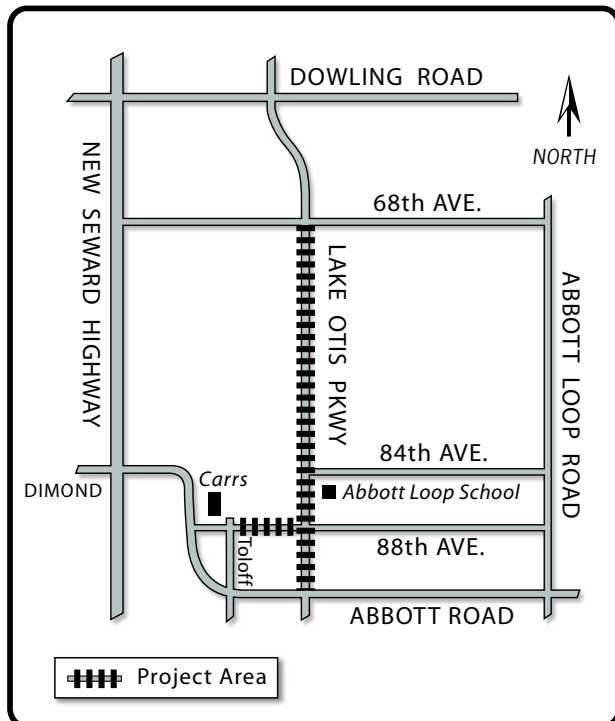
